There is no age limit for appearing in U-SET 2017.

The candidates must have Master's Degree recognized by U.G.C. Candidates having Post Graduate diploma/certificate awarded by Indian University/Institute or Foreign degree/diploma/certificate awarded by any Foreign University/Institute should in their own interest, ascertain the equivalence of their diploma/degree/certificate with Master's degree of recognized Indian Universities from Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi (www.aiuweb.org).

Candidates who have secured at least 55% marks (without rounding off) in Master's Degree OR equivalent from universities/institutions recognised by UGC and State Government are eligible for this Test. The OBC (Non- creamy layer)/SC/ST/PWD(persons with disability) category candidates who have secured at least 50% marks (without rounding off) in Master's degree or equivalent are eligible for this Test.

The Ph.D. degree holders whose Master's level examination had been completed by 19th September, 1991 (irrespective of date of declaration of result) shall be eligible for a relaxation of 5% in aggregate marks (i.e. from 55% to 50%) for appearing in U-SET.

Candidates who have appeared OR will be appearing at the qualifying master's degree (Final year) examination and whose result is still awaited OR candidates whose qualifying examinations have been delayed may also apply for this Test. However, such candidates will be admitted provisionally and shall be considered eligible for the post of Assistant Professor only after they have passed their Master's degree examination with at least 55% marks (50% in case of OBC(Non- creamy layer)/SC/ST/PWD(persons with disability) category candidates). Such candidates must complete their P.G. degree examination within two years from the date of U-SET result with required percentage of marks, failing which they shall be treated as disqualified. Those candidate who qualify U-SET Examination will be issued the certificate after they have passed their Master's Degree examination with at least 55% marks (50% in case of SC/ST/PH/VH/OBC Non Creamy Category candidates) and submit their P.G. Mark sheet within two years from the date of declaration of result of the U-SET examination.

There is no upper age limit for appearing in the U-SET.

SC/ST/ PWD/OBC (Non Creamy Layer) candidates must ensure that they possess attested copy of their category certificate and the latest valid non creamy layer certificate (not older than one year) in case of OBC. The certificate must be in candidate's own name only. The candidates will be considered as GENERAL Category if they fail to produce valid Category Certificate and the latest non creamy layer certificate(in case of OBC) released by Uttarakhand Govt. in support of their claim for relaxation in marks, fee, etc.

The Test will consist of three papers. All the three papers will consist of only objective type questions and will be held on 29.10.2017 (SUNDAY) in two separate sessions as under:

Candidates should occupy their seats in the examination hall 20 minutes before commencement of the examination. No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall/room before 11.30 a.m. in the 1st session and 3.30 p.m. in the second session.

Paper-I shall be of general nature, intended to assess the teaching/research aptitude of the candidate. It will primarily be designed to test reasoning ability, comprehension, divergent thinking and general awareness of the candidate. Sixty (60) multiple choice questions of two marks each will be given, out of which the candidate would be required to answer any fifty (50). In the event of the candidate attempting more than fifty questions, the first fifty questions attempted by the candidate would be evaluated.

Paper-II shall consist of 50 objective type compulsory questions based on the subject selected by the candidate. Each question will carry 2 marks.

Paper-III will consist of 75 objective type compulsory questions from the subject selected by the candidate. Each question will carry 2 marks.

- All questions of Paper-II and Paper-III will be compulsory, covering entire syllabus (including all electives, without options).
- The candidate will have to mark the responses for questions of Paper-I, Paper-II and Paper-III on the Optical Mark Reader (OMR) sheet provided along with the Test Booklet by black or blue ball point pen only.
- The detailed instructions for filling up the OMR Sheet will be uploaded on U-SET website (https://www.usetonline.com) with a link at Kumaun University website (https://www.kunainital.ac.in) in the last week of August 2017. It may be noted that instructions to candidates will not be sent to the candidates by post.
- For Persons with Disability (Visually Challenged candidates) twenty five minutes compensatory time shall be provided separately for paper-I and Paper-II. For paper-III, fifty minutes compensatory time shall be provided. They will also be provided the services of a scribe who would be a graduate in a subject other than that of the candidate.
- The Persons with Disability (Physically Challenged) candidates who are not in a position to write in their own hand-writing can also avail these services by making prior request (at least one week before the date of U-SET) in writing to the Member Secretary of the U-SET Coordinating Institution. Compensatory time and facility of scribe would not be provided to other Persons with Disability (Physically Challenged) candidates who have disability of less than 40%.

U-SET Coordinating institution will not send the syllabus to individual candidates.
- In case of any discrepancy found in the English and Hindi versions, the questions in English version shall be taken as final.
- The U-SET agency will upload marks statement on its website. The U-SET agency will issue certificate to qualifying candidates only.

CRITERIA FOR DECLARATION OF RESULT This will comprise the following:

Top 6% of the appearing candidates who appear in all three papers and secure atleast 40% aggregate marks for candidates belonging to General category and atleast 35% aggregate marks for candidates belonging to reserved categories will be declared qualified for eligibility for Assistant Professor by following the reservation policy of the State Government.

It may be noted that the above qualifying criteria is final and binding.
