Applications are invited from interested eligible bonafide citizens of India for filling up the following vacancies under the Government of Nagaland in the manner prescribed below:

| 2. | Science | 53 | i) Graduate in Science stream with 50% marks relaxable by 5% for Scheduled Tribe/Scheduled Caste/Differently abled candidates at the Bachelor's degree level from a recognised university. ii) B.Ed, B.A.Ed/B.Sc.Ed from any National Council of Teachers Education recognised institution; and iii) The candidate must have cleared State Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) conducted by SCERT |

2. Relaxation in Educational Qualification:

- i. 1st Preference will be given to those candidates fulfilling all the 3 required qualifications.
- ii. 2nd Preference will be given to those candidates having No. (i) & (ii) qualifications.
- iii. If sufficient number of Candidates having (i) and (ii) qualifications are not available, Indigenous Inhabitant Candidates fulfilling only qualification No. (i) will be considered on the condition that they acquire B.Ed course within 5 years if selected in the written examination.

NOTE:

- i) The upper age is relaxable by:
- (a) 5 (Five) years for SC/ST Candidates.
 - (b) Age relaxation for serving Government Employees shall be allowed equal to the number of years they are in service, subject to a maximum of 5 (Five) years.
 - (c) For Differently abled persons, the upper age limit will be permitted relaxation of 10 (Ten) years.
5. Implementation of reservation policy for Indigenous Inhabitants of the State of Nagaland and Backward Tribes including Sumis of Kiphire District shall be made in accordance with the terms of the existing reservation policy of the government of Nagaland issued vide notification No.RCBT-5/87(Pt.-II) Dated 14-04-2011, 15-06-2012 and 04-09-2015.
6. Reservation for Physically Challenged Candidates, wherever applicable, shall be as per Government Notification NO.AR/Gen-9/97 dated 16-01-08.
7. a) Selection of Candidates in order of Merit shall be on the basis of the performance of candidates in the academic records and written examination with the following weightage:-
- i) Academic Records: = 40%
 - ii) Written Examination: = 60%
- b) The weightage for academic records for all categories of Graduate Teachers shall be provided under: -

| 1 | HSLC Examination | 10% of the aggregate marks |
| 2 | 10+ 2 Examination | 15% of the aggregate marks |
| 3 | Degree level Examination | 35% of the aggregate marks |
| 4 | B.Ed | 35% of the aggregate marks |
| 5 | Honours or higher qualifications like PG/M.Phil/Ph.D | 5% marks bonus |

c) For the Written Examination, there will be 2 (Two) Papers of 300 Marks.

- i) Relevant Subject- a) Paper- I (150 Marks)
b) Paper- II (150 Marks)

ii) There shall be no Viva-Voce for the above Recruitment Examination. The written Examination shall determine the merit of the Candidates.

d) Tentative merit list of 3 times the number of vacancies shall be prepared based on the performance of candidates in the written examinations.

e) A waiting list, not exceeding 25% of the vacancies advertised, shall be maintained by the Board. The waiting list shall remain valid for a period of six months from the date of the results declared by the Board.

Provided that the arrangement of the names of the qualified candidates in order of merit shall be subject to the reservation policy for scheduled Tribes and Backward tribes as per instruction issued by the Government from time to time.

f) Syllabus and Pattern of Examination can be downloaded from the Nagaland State Portal.

8. Only those candidates who possess the requisite qualification shall be eligible to apply for the post at the time of applying. A candidate will be allowed to apply for only one post.

9. Candidates must completely fill in the form by providing accurate information in all matters (Date of Birth, etc). **IN CASE IT IS DETECTED AT ANY STAGE OF RECRUITMENT THAT A CANDIDATE DOES NOT FULFILL THE ELIGIBILITY NORMS AND/OR THAT HE/SHE HAS FURNISHED INCORRECT OR FALSE INFORMATION OR HAS SUPPRESSED ANY MATERIAL FACT(S), HIS/HER CANDIDATURE SHALL BE SUMMARILY REJECTED.**

10. Candidates must submit self-attested Photo copies of the following documents in a sealed envelope with Name and Roll Number addressed to the **Principal Director, Directorate of School Education, Kohima** on the day of the examination:

- (a) 2 (two) recent passport with name and signature on the backside of the same.
- (b) HSLC/Matriculation/Equivalent Admit Card for proof of Date of Birth. No other Certificate will be accepted for age proof.
- (c) Mark Sheets from HSLC/Equivalent onwards till requisite qualification.
- (d) Pass Certificate of HSLC, HSSLC & Degree issued by Board/University. In absence of Degree pass certificate issued by University, candidates may submit provisional pass Certificate issued by Institution/university.
- (e) Pass Certificate of B.Ed, B.A.Ed/B.Sc.Ed from any National Council of Teacher Education recognized institution.
- (f) Pass Certificate of State Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) conducted by SCERT
- (g) For physically handicapped candidate, certificate from competent medical authority.
- (h) Indigenous Inhabitant Certificate (I.I.C.), S.C./S.T. & B.T. (if applicable) certificate. *Indigenous Inhabitant Certificate, S.C./S.T. & B.T. certificates should be signed only by District Authority not below the rank of Additional Deputy Commissioner.*
- (i) For candidates who are Government Employees "NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE" should be produced duly signed by the Head of the Department, with Name and Office Seal, along with date of appointment.
- (j) Candidates selected in the merit list must bring the Originals of Marksheets and Pass Certificates of all educational qualifications from matriculation onwards and requisite qualification together with HSLC Admit Card for proof of age and all other relevant documents like S.T./I.I./B.T. Certificates etc. for verification.

11. **Only online applications shall be accepted.**

12. *Candidates are advised to apply online much before the closing date and not to wait till the last date to avoid the possibility of disconnection/ inability/failure to log on to the website on account of heavy load on internet or website jam.*


13. **Examination fee (online applications only) will be Rs.450 (Rupees Four hundred and fifty only). Fees once paid will not be refundable.**

14. **Last date of submission of online application form: 15-09-2017, 3:00 P.M.**


15. **The written examination will be held on 25-09-2017 from 10:00 to 12:00 Hrs. and from 13:00 to 15:00 Hrs.**

16. **INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING ONLINE:**

- i. Candidates can apply Online through the Nagaland State Portal at <https://nagaland.gov.in> or through any Nagaland One Common Service Center (CSC).
- ii. All fields marked as * on the eForm are mandatory.
- iii. Instructions for uploading photograph and signature:
 - a. Candidate must upload clear scanned images of their photograph and signature.
 - b. Size of photograph should be 200 pixels width x 250 pixels height.
 - c. Size of signature should be 250 pixels width x 120 pixels height.
- iv. Instructions for making online payment for examination fee (**Rs.460**):
 - a. After submitting the eForm, candidate shall click on the Preview Button and review all the details for correctness in the submitted eForm.
 - b. If any information is incorrect or photograph/signature has not been correctly uploaded, candidate may submit a new application.
 - c. After candidate is satisfied that all information is correct and photograph & signature have been correctly uploaded, proceed to make online payment.



- d. Page will be re-directed to NDML payment page.
- e. Candidate will select payment option: Debit Card, Internet Banking, Credit Card.
- f. Candidate will select the bank and be re-directed to the bank payment page.
- g. Fill in the required details and proceed to make payment.
- h. After making payment, page will be re-directed to the State Portal payment confirmation page. Only then, the candidate's online application form shall be routed to the Department.
- i. Candidates are advised to check the payment status in their State Portal inbox. If the payment status shows "Completed", the form has been successfully submitted. If the payment status shows "Pending" the candidate must make payment again by clicking "Pending" If more than one payment is made for the same application the excess amount will be refunded.
- v. *Candidates who apply from any CSC may make payment by cash a sum of Rs.500 (Rupees five hundred only) of which Rs.460 (Rupees Four hundred and fifty only) is for examination & convenience fee and additional Rs. 40 (Rupees Forty only) for CSC service charge which includes scanning, filling up of eForm and transaction fee.*
- vi. Candidates should note down the **Transaction ID** of their eForm which will be required later for downloading **Admission Certificate** and for future reference.
